The Annual Highlander is the oldest invitational golf tournament in the Midwest.

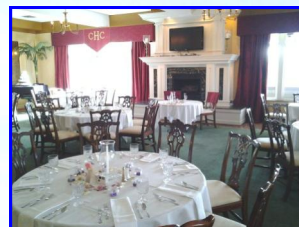
